

Institution Of Suit S.26 Or.4

SUIT COMMENCES BY PRESENTATION OF PLAINT Or. 7

- Plaint shall contain all particulars
- And all material facts
- Defendant's liability to be shown
- Relief to be specifically stated
- Production of document with plaint
- Amendment of plaint
- Return of plaint
- Rejection of plaint

REGISTER OF SUIT

- Court shall maintain a register
- Particulars be entered in the register
- Entries shall be numbered in the year

Substituted Mode Of Service

APPEARANCE

Case is Proceeded Further

Or.9

NON-APPEARANCE

- Ex-parte upon defendant's
- Suit dismissed in default upon plaintiff's

Written Statement Or.8

- Defendant shall present written statement of his defense.
- New facts must be specifically pleaded.
- Denial to be specific and not evasive.
- particulars of set-off to be given
- Failure to submit W.S, court pronounces judgment.
- Address for service to be filed.

Evidence Of The Parties Or.18

- Plaintiff has the right to begin
- Produce witnesses
- Examined in open court
- In the presence of judge
- Shall be taken in the language of court

Evidence Of Defendant

JUDGMENT S.33 / Or. 20

On closure of evidence arguments shall be heard on the whole case

- Pronounce in open court
- Judgment to be dated and signed
- Shall contain!
- > concise statement of case
- ➤ Points for determination
- Decision thereon
- Reasons for such decisions
- ➤ Shall follow decree

EXECUTION S.36To74 /Or.21

Powers of executing court/modes of execution of decree

S.51

- By delivery of possession
- By arrest and detention
- By attachment and sale
- By appointing a receiver
- By any other mode
