WHAT IS PROCESS

- A Series of actions or steps taken to achieve an end.
- Perform a series of operations in order to achieve the end.
- A Communication in order to take forward the judicial operation / activity.

Different modes of Process in vogue.

1. Summon
2. Notice
3. Warrant

WHAT IS SUMMON?

as to Judicial Process related definition

- A summon is "CAN" i.e court attendance notice.
- A call by Judicial Authority to appear, come or do something.
- In authoritative command, message or signal by which one is called to appear before a court or a judicial officer at specified place as far a particular purpose or duty.

WHAT IS NOTICE ?

Written or formal information, notification or warning about a fact required to be made in law or imparted by an operation of Law.

WARRANT

A written order issued by a judicial officer or other authorized person commanding a law enforcement officer to perform some act in furtherance of the administration of justice.
