

## CHAPTER 1 ADMINISTRATION

## A JOURNEY TOWARDS JUDICIAL EXCELLENCE: THE EVOLUTION OF JUDICIAL TRAINING IN KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA

The seeds of judicial education in Pakistan were sown as early as 1958, when the First Law Reforms Commission emphasized the need for rigorous hands-on training through mentorship programs—a visionary step to bridge theory and practice. By 1967, the Second Law Reforms Commission took this further, proposing a dedicated Judicial Academy to professionalize civil judges and magistrates. This dream finally took root in 1988 with the establishment of the Federal Judicial Academy (FJA), a milestone that transformed judicial training nationwide.

In Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, early training was modest—just two-week attachments for judges. But a breakthrough came in 1993 when the province's civil judges began attending the FJA's structured six-week pre-service training programs. By 2001, training became mandatory under the Judicial Service Rules, signaling a paradigm shift toward institutionalized excellence.

The 2003 reforms added precision: two-weeks training for District & Sessions Judges / Zila Qazis, three weeks for promoted Additional District & Sessions Judges / Izafi Zila Qazis and Senior Civil Judges / A'ala Ilaqa Qazis, and four to eight weeks for newly recruited Additional District & Sessions Judges / Izafi Zila Qazis and Civil Judges / Ilaqa Qazis. This era also saw districts buzzing with workshops and seminars—grassroots momentum that sparked a bold idea: Why not a provincial judicial academy?

From Vision to Reality: Birth of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Judicial Academy

In 2008, the Peshawar High Court (PHC) ignited this vision by founding a Judicial Training Centre. By 2011, relentless advocacy by PHC leadership turned this into a mission. Meetings with provincial officials, strategic lobbying, and unwavering resolve culminated in the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Judicial Academy's inauguration in March 2011. Dr. Khurshid Iqbal, a seasoned judge, steered its launch, kick starting operations with a landmark two-day orientation for court staff.

The academy's fate accelerated under Chief Justice Dost Muhammad Khan, who took office in late 2011. His impassioned appeal to the Provincial Law Minister—"Establish this academy now, not later"—echoed as a rallying cry. By December 28, 2011, the Governor's Ordinance gave it legal teeth, and weeks later, the Provincial Assembly passed the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Judicial Academy Act (2012), etching it into history.

A Legacy of Transformation

What began as short-term attachments in the 1950s evolved into a flagship institution—a testament to Pakistan's commitment to judicial professionalism. Today, the Academy stands

not just as a training hub but as a beacon of innovation, empowering judges with skills to deliver justice in an ever-changing world.

This journey—from ad-hoc mentorship to a world-class Academy—reflects a relentless pursuit of excellence, proving that visionary leadership and persistence can turn even the boldest ideas into enduring institutions.

#### AIMS AND OBJECTIVES OF KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA JUDICIAL ACADEMY

The Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Judicial Academy (KPJA) is a premier institution for imparting judicial education and training for all stakeholders of the justice sector. Its primary objective is to conduct comprehensive training programs for judges, qazis, magistrates, lawyers, law officers, prosecutors, jail personnel, court staff and the like, for development of their professional competence, through enhancing knowledge, skills, and polishing conduct and mannerism. The institution is mainly concerned with the formulation and implementation of a continuing program of judicial education for pre-service and in-service training of judges. Besides, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Judicial Academy also caters to the needs of Paralegals, Oath Commissioners, Petition writers, Stamp vendors and all others related staff.

Apart from training, KPJA is mandated by the Act to conduct conferences, seminars, workshops, and symposia for improving judicial system and quality of judicial work according to the emergent needs and current circumstances. This mandates the Academy to design, tailor and adapt any knowledge-sharing module on any contemporary legal issue or challenge. In line with this objective, the Academy conducts regular workshops, seminars, conferences, focused group discussions and events on various specialized areas of law, for all stakeholders in the judicial process and for ensuring expeditious dispensation of justice.

A primary objective behind establishing the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Judicial Academy (KPJA) was to create an institute dedicated to researching contemporary legal issues and judicial challenges, with the aim of sharing outcomes with policymakers, legislative bodies, and academia. The Academy's Research and Publication Wing disseminates findings through publications such as journals, research papers, and reports. Among these efforts is its flagship journal, the *Peshawar Law Review*.

In an era marked by rapid technological advancements and evolving legal complexities, modern judiciary face unprecedented challenges. Pioneering research into legal grey areas—critical for driving systemic reforms and fostering an adaptable justice system—now informs both judicial training programs and the scholarly discourse within the *Peshawar Law Review*. The Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Judicial Academy (KPJA) serves as the premier hub for advancing judicial excellence, standardizing capacity-building initiatives, research culture, and innovative resources—from digital tools to procedural guides—to elevate judicial

administration. Leading with pioneering accredited mediation training for legal professionals, KPJA now champions the formalization of mediator standards and the integration of Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR), redefining justice beyond traditional courts.

#### VISION AND MISSION OF KPJA

The mission and vision of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Judicial Academy are centered on advancing the administration of justice through multifaceted initiatives aimed at enhancing professional competence and ethical standards. The Academy is committed to providing specialized training to judicial officers, court staff, and personnel from other departments and institutions linked to the justice system, ensuring a skilled workforce capable of upholding judicial integrity. Recognizing excellence, it awards certifications and distinctions to participants who successfully complete its programs, fostering a culture of merit and continuous learning. Beyond training, the Academy actively organizes conferences, seminars, workshops, and symposia to facilitate dialogue on contemporary legal challenges and reforms. It drives innovation by initiating research and publishing scholarly work on critical justice-related topics, while also forging partnerships with universities, academies, and institutions to promote collaborative knowledge exchange. Central to its ethos is the cultivation of ethical values and professional standards among judicial officers and stakeholders, reinforcing transparency, accountability, and public trust in the justice system. Through these efforts, the Academy aspires to be a cornerstone of judicial excellence and a catalyst for systemic improvement.

#### MANAGEMENT AND SUPERVISION OF THE ACADEMY

The Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Judicial Academy operates under the governance of a Board of Governors, chaired by the Hon'ble Chief Justice of Peshawar High Court. Established under Section 5 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Judicial Academy Act, 2012, the Board oversees the Academy's strategic planning, performance audits, and compliance with its objectives, while prescribing structured training programs tailored to participants' professional levels. The Director General, serving as the Principal Accounting Officer and academic-administrative head, manages day-to-day operations under the Board's directives. As a statutory body corporate, the Academy's governance framework ensures alignment with its mandate through tactical guidance and institutional oversight by the Board. #### POWERS AND FUNCTIONS OF THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS

The Board of Governors shall exercise supervision and control over the affairs of the Academy, lay down policies and programs for training, and initiate, modify, or adopt curricula, courses, modules, and clinics for orientation and training. It is tasked with organizing and overseeing the activities and performance of the Authority, approving the annual and revised budgets, managing financial affairs, ensuring proper maintenance and auditing of accounts, and specifying qualifications, service conditions, and employment matters for the director general, faculty members, and staff. The Board holds authority to create, abolish, suspend, or upgrade posts; acquire, construct, alter, or dispose of buildings, property, assets, and vehicles; affiliate the Academy with domestic or international institutions; appoint advisors, consultants, and experts; hire permanent or visiting faculty; and address any ancillary matters incidental to the Academy's objectives. Additionally, they oversee affiliations, partnerships, and logistical operations to advance the Academy's mission.

## MR. JUSTICE ISHTIAQ IBRAHIM, HON'BLE CHAIRMAN BOARD OF GOVERNORS, KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA JUDICIAL ACADEMY

Born into a respectable family in Peshawar on December 2, 1969, Mr. Justice Ishtiaq Ibrahim pursued his education with distinction. He completed his secondary schooling at University Public School, Peshawar, in 1985, followed by his Higher Secondary School Certificate from Government College, Peshawar, in 1987. He earned his Bachelor of Arts degree from Government College, Peshawar, in 1989 and his LLB from Khyber Law College, Peshawar, in 1992.



Mr. Justice Ishtiaq Ibrahim's legal career began with his enrollment as an Advocate of the District Courts in May 18, 1993. He was subsequently enrolled as an Advocate of the High Court in March 11, 1995, and as an Advocate of the Supreme Court of Pakistan in September 26, 2008.

His service at the Bar included appointments as Assistant Advocate General for Khyber Pakhtunkhwa from 1999 to 2000, Special Prosecutor for the National Accountability Bureau (NAB) from 2001 to 2002, and Additional Advocate General for Khyber Pakhtunkhwa from 2008 to 2010. He was also actively involved in the Peshawar High Court Bar Association, serving as Joint Secretary (1998-1999), General Secretary (2007-2008), and President (2013-2014).

Mr. Justice Ishtiaq Ibrahim was elevated to the Bench as Additional Judge of the Peshawar High Court on August 11, 2016. The Judicial Commission granted him a one-year extension on July 25, 2017, and he was confirmed as Permanent Judge on June 1, 2018.

He assumed the role of Acting Chief Justice of the Peshawar High Court on April 15, 2024, and was subsequently sworn in as Chief Justice on April 20, 2024.

## MR. JUSTICE IJAZ ANWAR, HON'BLE VICE-CHAIRMAN BOARD OF GOVERNORS, KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA JUDICIAL ACADEMY

Mr. Justice Ijaz Anwar was born in Peshawar to a respectable family on January 15, 1968. He earned his B.A. and LL.B from University of Peshawar. He was admitted as an advocate to District Courts in 1993, the High Court in 1997, and the Supreme Court of Pakistan in 2008. From 1997 to 2015, Mr. Justice Ijaz Anwar served as legal advisor and was on the Panel of Advocates to a wide range of institutions and organizations. He was an



Executive Member for Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Pakistan Services Bar Association Islamabad and a Member of the Academic Council of Shariah and Law, Islamia College Peshawar. In 2016, he was made a pioneer member of the Board of Governors for Medical Teaching Institutions at several hospitals. He also lectured at the Staff Training Institute, Peshawar. Elevated to the Peshawar High Court as an Additional Judge in 2017 and confirmed as a permanent Judge in 2018, Justice Ijaz Anwar has held numerous judicial positions including Chairman Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Subordinate Judiciary Service Tribunal, Judge Labour Appellate Tribunal and Special Appellate Court, Customs Judge under the Financial Institution (Recovery of Finance) Ordinance, 2001, Judge Elections Tribunal, Administrative Judge Special Courts and Anti-Terrorism Courts, and Administrative Judge overseeing prison conditions. He has chaired the Enrolment Committee of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Bar Council and served as member of the Administrative Committee of the Peshawar High Court. Furthermore, he has chaired a Sub-Committee on Jail Reforms for Khyber Pakhtunkhwa under the Law and Justice Commission of Pakistan. Justice Ijaz Anwar's professional development includes training on human rights at the University of Hull, United Kingdom, and attendance at the Pakistan International Disputes Weekend Karachi, 2024.

#### MR. JUSTICE SYED ARSHAD ALI, ADVISOR, KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA JUDICIAL ACADEMY



Born to a respectable family in the Swabi district on April 10, 1971, his foundational education culminated in LLB degree from the University of Peshawar, setting the stage for his legal career. His enrollment as an Advocate of the High Court in 1996 marked an early milestone, demonstrating his proficiency and readiness to practice law at a higher level.



His pursuit of legal excellence continued, leading to his enrollment as an Advocate of the Supreme Court in 2012. This achievement underscored his deep understanding of complex legal principles and his ability to navigate the highest court in the land. 

#### MR. JEHANZEB SHINWARI DIRECTOR GENERAL

Jehanzeb Shinwari, the Director General of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Judicial Academy, boasts an illustrious career spanning over two decades in the legal and judicial arena. Beginning as Civil Judge cum Judicial Magistrate (2003-2006), he adeptly handled a wide array of cases, including civil, criminal, family, rent, narcotics, succession, and guardianship matters. His role as an Additional District & Sessions Judge (2006-2015) saw him preside over appellate and revision courts, tackling complex civil, family, and criminal cases, including grave offenses like murder. Since 2015, he has served as District & Sessions Judge, leading



district judiciary administration, functioning as an appellate court, justice of peace, and adjudicating sessions and special court cases involving murder, narcotics, and other serious crimes.

A versatile legal expert, Mr. Jehanzeb Shinwari has held pivotal positions such as Judge of the Consumer Protection Court, Anti-Terrorism Court, and currently, Director General of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Judicial Academy. His early career included practicing law (1992-1998) in district and high courts, where he managed diverse legal cases. Beyond the courtroom, he has contributed significantly as a Returning Officer for elections, Litigation Officer for the KP government, and Deputy Provincial Programme Manager for the Access to Justice Programme. A respected judicial educator, he trains judges and lawyers on court management and legal procedures.

#### MR. AURANGZEB KHAN KHALIL STATION DIRECTOR

## MR. DOST MUHAMMAD KHAN SENIOR DIRECTOR ADMINISTRATION



#### **Additional Accounts: -**

In pursuance of recommendation by the finance committee of the Academy held on 13.02.2024, Finance Department Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa agreed to allocate fund amounting to Rs. 240.000 million as grant-in-aid for the current financial year 2024-25.

During 2024, a sum of Rs. 5,908,934/- was earned from training, workshops and seminars. After approval of hon'ble the Chief Justice, Peshawar High Court, Peshawar/Chairman, the earning and balance of Rs. 4,000,000/- was transferred to endowment fund in March 2024 for strengthening the same.

A profit of Rs. 57,400,000/- is expected from the investment made by the Academy towards the endowment fund kept in Bank of Khyber, Peshawar High Court branch, Peshawar.

#### **Endowment Fund**

To make the Academy self-sustainable and to reduce its dependency on Provincial Government, Endowment Fund was created during the year 2012-13. Initially, an amount of Rs 50.000 million was released by the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa as seed money. The profit & earnings of the Academy were re-invested over the period, 2013-24 as per details given below: -

#### **Annual Calendar 2024**



Aligned with the Peshawar High Court's vision, the Academy designs an annual dynamic syllabus addressing current and future judicial needs, equipping participants with skills to tackle contemporary challenges. On successful completion of training, certificates were conferred upon the trainees.









# CHAPTER 4 RESEARCH & PUBLICATION CADRE

A primary goal of the Academy is to deliver judicial education and promote research in law and judicial studies, alongside cultivating a research-oriented environment and enhancing human resource development through education grounded in research.

The Research Wing releases bi-annual Newsletters, Annual Report, and Bench Book. It also assists the Academic Wing by developing and implementing pre and post-training assessments to evaluate the effectiveness of training initiatives and guide the creation of future modules. Furthermore, the Research Wing contributes to the preparation of training reports. The initiatives of the Research & Publication wing can be summed up as below:

### COLLECTION DEVELOPMENT & REVAMPING OF THE LIBRARY

In alignment with the vision of the Worthy Director General, the Research Wing undertook a comprehensive revamping of the Central Library. This initiative involved reorganizing the book collection according to subject-wise classification to enhance accessibility for readers and researchers. Dedicated shelves were established for each legal discipline, with Subject Display Plates prominently



displayed to assist in navigation. Additionally, a cleanliness drive was conducted, which included a thorough dusting of the library facilities. As part of the collection development efforts, a total of 500 new books were acquired through both purchases and donations.

#### RESEARCH MASTERPIECES

The Research and Publication Wing has undertaken multiple research initiatives. Following the directives of the Hon'ble Chairman KPJA, the Wing conducted a study on the impact of a Judge/Qazi's Vocal Tone during Hearings. Additionally, it developed guidelines on research skills and methodology, as well as book review guidelines.

Moreover, the wing carried out an in-depth investigation into the concept of bail in criminal cases, particularly those filed under blasphemy laws. To enhance participants' understanding of creative writing, interactive sessions on research skills and methodology were conducted during pre-service training programs. These sessions familiarized participants with the process of writing research articles, theses, and proposals, supplemented by practical exercises on research article writing and book review.

All research outputs have been made available on the Academy's website, and select findings have also been shared with the Hon'ble Peshawar High Court, Peshawar.





# CHAPTER 5 MANAGEMENT INFORMATION SYSTEM CADRE

The Management Information Cadre is an integral part of the Academy which provides essential support and assistance to all other cadres. The initiatives of the Cadre are as under:

#### **Up-Grading Network Infrastructure**

The Management Information Cadre undertook up-gradation of network infrastructure. In phase-I of network infrastructure up-gradation Optical Fiber installation was successfully completed in hostel and office buildings, ensuring high-speed connectivity.

#### **Classroom Modernization**

In line with the vision of DG Academy the Cadre undertook another initiative aimed at modernization of Academy's classrooms. The classrooms were upgraded to ensure interactive learning environments, enhancing the educational experience. It implemented live streaming systems for internal and external classroom monitoring. In the same



direction it established wireless access to Peshawar High Court and District Courts, enabling remote participation.

Radio Meezan consists of different programs as per the details below.

- 1. *Qanoni Larey Charey*: This is an introductory program aired on daily basis. So far this segment covered different topics like, civil, criminal, family, child rights, and many more. Renowned lawyers participated in this segment including Shahab Khattak Advocate, Maulana Shams ul Haq Advocate, Muhammad Fakhr-e-alam Advocate, Sahibzada Sikandar Advocate, and Khizar Hayat Advocate.
- **2.** *Qanoondan Studio Mai*: This was a weekly segment which covered specialized subjects like Service Laws, Labour Laws, and Banking Laws. The Guest speakers were Fakhr-e-Alam Advocate and Zafar Tahirkheli Advocate.
- **3.** Baccho Kay Hqooq: This subject covered laws related to children. Different Lawyers and Child Rights Activists i.e Khizar Hayat Advocate, Fakhr-e-Alam Advocate, Mr. Irfan Khan Director Labour Department, Barrister Azam Khan,

- Sahibzada Sikandar Advocate, Ms. Wadiya Mushtaq Malik (Additional Sessions Judge) and Amna Durrani Director *Zamong Kor* participated in this segment.
- 4. Sinfi Imtiaz Aur Qanoon: The only purpose of this program is to highlight laws related to women rights. Guest Speakers from different governmental and nongovernmental organizations i.e. Ms. Rubina Naz, Member Women Commission, Ms. Amna Durrani, Fakhr-e-Alam Advocate, Rakhshanda Naz Ombudsperson Commission on harassment at workplace, Shams ul Haq Advocate, and Amna Durrani Program Director Commission on the status of women participated in this program. The main purpose was to sensitize the audience about different laws related to this section of the society.
- **5.** *Islam Ao Qanoon*: This program mainly focused Islamic laws. Till now this evergreen program covered different topics. Maulana Shams ul Haq Advocate is the permanent host of this weekly program.
- 6. Program on Right to Information Act: The Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa passed a law, called Right to Information. The main aim of this program was awareness of the general public regarding the effectiveness of this enactment. Sayyed Sadat Jehan, Deputy Director Right to Information, discussed the law in detail and responded to queries raised by the listeners and followers of the social media pages of Radio Meezan.
- 7. Program on Right to Services Act: Radio Meezan took initiative to disseminate awareness regarding this special subject. Chief Commissioner Mr. Saleem Khan (ex-Chief Secretary) participated in the introductory program. Later, Mr. Asim Imam Commissioner-I and Mr. Zakir Hussain Afridi Commissioner-II also attended the program. The page Admin updated the status on different social media pages of Radio Meezan and asked the followers to share their questions regarding the said subject. The Guest Speakers not only discussed the law but also gave detail answers of the questions raised by the followers.
- **8. Traffic Laws:** In order to sensitize the general public regarding Traffic Laws, a special program under this title was aired in three episodes. The awareness session was headed by Incharge Traffic Education Mr. Asif Raza while further details regarding different laws were shared by SP Traffic Ms. Shazia Shahid. The experts also shared different fines in case of violations of traffic rules.
- **9.** Naya Safar: A program was designed with the newly appointed Civil Judges / Ilaqa Qazis to share their experience regarding the extra ordinary journey of

- becoming a judicial officer. The participants shared their experience about appearing in competitive examinations and also shared tips to the audience.
- **10.** *Fikr-o-Nazar*: It is a specialized program for discussing different laws on relevant topics in a scholarly manner. Different scholars like Dr. Qibla Ayaz (Chairman IIC), Mr. Shahab Khattak Advocate, and Maulana Shams ul Haq Advocate participated in this weekly program.
- **11.** *Hafta-e-Rafta*: This is a weekly news review program. This program mainly covers the news aired during the last week in scripted form. Mr. Rafique Kamran news reader of Urdu language prepared a script from the already broadcast news.

## 12. Detail Of Spotify, Islam Ao Qanon, Da Pakistan Ayen and Qanoni Larey Charey:

A total of 706 programs were uploaded to platforms such as Spotify and Podcasts, covering an extensive range of legal topics. Notable programs included "Da Pakistan Ayen (26<sup>th</sup> Amendment)" featuring Barrister Dr. Adnan Khan, , "Islam Ao Qanoon" with insights from Maulana Shams ul Haq Advocate, *Qanoni Larey Charey* covering various topics like, civil, criminal, family, service and the like. These programs provided invaluable insights into various legal aspects, ensuring accessibility to legal information for the public.

#### **Upcoming Programs**

#### Qanon Qadam Pa Qadam, International Humanitarian Law and Consumer Protection

In line with its commitment to disseminate awareness regarding legislation of the Provincial Assembly of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa in 2024 Radio Meezan launched a weekly program "Qanon Qadam Pa Qadam". Radio Meezan received a list of legislation from the Assembly and concerned departments were asked to share their input regarding amendments in the relevant Acts. Another significant initiative is the program titled "International Humanitarian law, by Mr. Akhtar Ali Khan Advocate to discuss different aspects of this Subject. A weekly program on Consumer protection laws is also a part of the existing schedule. Recently team Radio Meezan headed by the Station Director visited Consumer Court Haripur and recorded programs with Judge Consumer Court Ms. Muneera Abbasi.

#### **Activities of KP Judicial Academy Peshawar**

The activities of KP Judicial Academy will be highlighted in this weekly program. The basic aim of this program is to inform the general public regarding different training sessions of the Academy.

#### Programs Mashal-E-Rah and Vox Pop With Litigant Public

In line with expanding its programming horizon, Radio Meezan introduced a program "Mash'al-e-Rah" based on a book written by Mr. Zia Ur Rehman Dean Faculty KPJA. The content will be discussed by the guest speakers (Maulana Shams ul Haq advocate). Another important program is "Vox Pop" series of interviews with litigant public of different District Courts so as to know their feedback regarding court process. To materialize this goal, team Radio Meezan visited courts and interviewed litigants about their problems and subsequent redress by the authorities concerned.

#### **Using Social Media Platforms for Uploading Programs**

Video of each program of Radio Meezan will be uploaded to different social media platforms i.e. Facebook, twitter, instagram and youtube. The links of these pages has already been shared with the followers through the Facebook page of Radio Meezan. Different programs have already been uploaded to the different social media pages of Radio Meezan and listeners are taking keen interest by liking, sharing and comments.

#### **Program on Custom Laws**

Moving towards educating the listeners, a program is scheduled to be aired on custom laws. The issues of interest to the public at large will be discussed by the guest speaker. The video of this program will also be helpful for general public. Not only the different topics but listener's questions will also be addressed during the program.

Looking ahead, Radio Meezan is poised to continue its mission of legal education, advocacy, and societal empowerment, contributing to a more informed, just, and equitable society in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

#### LL.B Course, the Remaining Lectures To Be Aired

Committed to its mission, Radio Meezan will soon start a lecture series based on LLB course by inviting renowned lecturers of different Law Colleges. Radio Meezan is airing lectures in its routine transmission but this will cover the remaining course by focusing on the latest curriculum. An updated curriculum has been received to cover the missing lectures.

#### Programs Regarding Human Rights Cell Peshawar High Court, Peshawar

The station aims to foster public awareness and engagement through programs such as "Sawal Aap Ky Jawab Hamary," shedding light on the role of the Human Rights Cell of Peshawar High Court. The process of receiving complaints and their redress by the Cell will be discussed during the program. An introductory session will be recorded with the Director HRC followed by queries by the public.

#### Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Services Tribunal

In order to share information to the Government Servants regarding Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal, a program is scheduled to be recorded with its Chairman. The Chairman has given his consent as a guest speaker. Moreover, a special program on Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal Amendment bill 2024 is also a part of this program.

#### **Coverage Area**

As per license issued by PEMRA, the radius area of Radio Meezan is 10 km. However, efforts are underway to increase its covering area. As a result the transmission will be listened in far flung areas. Furthermore, an idea of sub stations is also in pipeline for introducing a network of Radio Meezan.

# CHAPTER 7 MAINTENANCE, REPAIR & DEVELOPMENT

#### 1. Repair of CCTV Cameras:

To enhance security and ensure the safety of staff, trainees, and visitors, the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Judicial Academy has undertaken installation of state-of-the-art CCTV cameras across its premises. The surveillance system will cover key areas, including entrances, classrooms, administrative offices, and outdoor spaces. This initiative aims to monitor activities, prevent unauthorized access, and maintain a secure environment conducive to learning and professional development.

#### 2. Renovation of Academy Building:

The Academy has initiated a comprehensive renovation plan for its existing building to modernize facilities and improve infrastructure. The renovation includes upgrades to classrooms, conference hall, administrative offices, and residential hostel for trainees and faculty. The project focuses on creating a more functional and aesthetically pleasing environment, ensuring the Academy meets international standards for judicial training institutions.

#### 3. Installation of Biometric Devices:

To streamline attendance tracking and enhance accountability, biometric devices have been installed at Academy. These devices will be used for staff and faculty to record attendance accurately and efficiently. The move is part of the Academy's efforts to adopt technology-driven solutions for better administrative management and transparency.



#### 4. Approval of Land Acquisition in Malam Jabba:

The Academy has received approval for the acquisition of land in Malam Jabba, a scenic location in the Swat Valley. The new site is intended for the expansion of the Academy's facilities, including the construction of additional training centers,

residential accommodations, and recreational areas. The serene environment of Malam Jabba is expected to provide an ideal setting for judicial training and professional development programs.

#### Masjid:

The Administration Wing of the Academy has undertaken a significant project to renovate and repair its *Masjid* to provide a more comfortable and functional space for worship and spiritual activities. The initiative includes structural repairs, aesthetic enhancements, and the installation of modern amenities to ensure the mosque meets the needs of its users.

#### i. Renovation and Repairing:

The mosque renovation focuses on addressing structural issues, such as repairing cracks, waterproofing, and reinforcing the building to ensure its longevity. The interior and exterior walls are being repainted, and the flooring is being upgraded to create a clean and serene environment. Additionally, the ablution area is being refurbished to improve hygiene and convenience for worshippers.

#### ii. Installation of Hot Water Geysers:

To enhance comfort, especially during the colder months, hot water geysers have been installed in the mosque's ablution area. This upgrade ensures that worshippers have access to warm water for wudu (ablution), making the experience more pleasant and accommodating for all.

#### iii. Lighting Improvements:

New energy-efficient lighting systems have been installed both inside and outside the mosque. The interior lighting has been designed to create a peaceful and well-lit environment for prayers, while the exterior lighting enhances safety and visibility during evening and nighttime use. The lighting system also includes motion sensors to optimize energy usage.

This project reflects the Academy's commitment to providing a welcoming and well-maintained space for spiritual activities, ensuring that the mosque serves as a place of

comfort and tranquility for staff, trainees, and visitors. The upgrades align with the Academy's broader goal of improving facilities and fostering a holistic environment for personal and professional growth.

#### 5. Acquisition of 150-Kanal Land in Regi Model Town, Peshawar

The Peshawar Development Authority had approved allotment of 150-Kanal land for the construction of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Judicial Academy at Regi Model Town, Peshawar @ Rs 2,500,000/- per Kanal vide letter No. 3.01.77/47/10 dated 22/05/2012. A sum of Rs 400.00 million was reflected in ADP for the subject scheme for the year 2015-16. However, in the meeting of the PDWP held on 15.9.2017 under the chairmanship of the Additional Chief Secretary, following decisions were made:

- The project was approved at the reduced cost of Rs 290.00 million.
- Instead of 150 Kanals, only 95 Kanals were allowed.
- The possession charges were deleted from PC-I

In light of the minutes of the meeting, Administrative Approval was granted for a sum of Rs290.00 million by the Peshawar High Court. The same stands reflected in the ADP Scheme.

Subsequently, in compliance with the decision of Board of Governors (BoG) taken in its 9<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 22.4.2019, a fresh summary was moved to the Provincial Government for increasing the area of land from 95-Kanal to 150-Kanal, which was duly approved by the Chief Minister, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

In pursuance of the approval of the Chief Minister, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Peshawar Development Authority (PDA), approved the allotment of 150-Kanal land for the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Judicial Academy at Regi Model Town, Peshawar at the following rates: -

The Secretary to Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Communication & Works Department, Peshawar was requested to revise the PC-I/Detail Cost Estimates in accordance with the cost of land and other matters incidental or ancillary thereto in the light of aforementioned approval of 150 Kanal of land so that the same be placed before PDWP for consideration and approval.

#### 6. Inauguration of Judicial Officers Mess

This year, the Academy formally inaugurated Judicial Officers Mess JOM for officers of the District Judiciary. Membership drive was carried out throughout the province. The judicial officers displayed keen interest in the drive. Membership cards were issued to the members. The facility is fully functional now and members are enjoying stay at affordable charges. The idea has been highly hailed by members of the District Judiciary.

#### 7. Solarization of the Academy

In 13<sup>th</sup> meeting, the Board was apprised about the solarization initiative taken-up by the Academy with Provincial Electric Inspector and the Pakhtunkhwa Energy Development Organization (PEDO). Appreciating the efforts made by the Academy, the Chair instructed the Additional Registrar (Admin), Peshawar High Court, Peshawar, to take-up the matter with PEDO on priority basis for solarization of the Academy and Peshawar High Court (PHC).

With the indulgence of PHC, a scheme for solarization of PHC and Academy was included in the ADP 2022-23. The PEDO conducted survey of the Academy on 04-10-2022 and submitted Technical Proposal as under:

The PEDO has proposed on-grid solar system with Net Metering facility and has estimated the gestation (payback period) as 3.64 years.

The Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Energy & Power Department (KPEP) has prepared and submitted PC-I/DCE through the PHC for review in light of requirements of the Academy. The estimated cost of the project is 26.33 million.

#### 8. ADOPTION OF CORPORATE-STYLE OFFICE WORK ENVIRONMENT

The Director General of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Judicial Academy introduced the new corporate-style offices, designed to enhance efficiency and professionalism within the Academy. These modern offices aim to create a productive work environment, reflecting the Academy's commitment to innovation and fostering a high standard of institutional administration. As part of this new initiative, the offices of Administration, Academics, Research and Publication, Information Technology, and Radio Meezan have been consolidated under one roof.
